2. Resolution #26-020 Authorizing Agreements with Up to Six Year-Two GII Pipeline Awardees

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Recommendation: I recommend the Council approve Resolution #26-020 authorizing the Chief Executive Officer to enter into up to six agreements with previous GII awardees noted in the agenda item for ongoing program implementation as well as up

to \$20,000 in capacity building funds, for a total amount not to exceed \$335,469 for FY 2026-2027, subject to the Council's annual budget and TRIM approval process.
